

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MOU)

BETWEEN

(Sponsoring Entity)

AND

Tennessee Wildlife Federation (TWF) and the Tennessee Scholastic Clay Target Program (TNSCTP) (Organization)

Whereas,

_____ (*Sponsoring Entity*) has a team with TNSCTP and agrees to abide by all the rules and regulations laid forth in the Policy and Procedures Manual, and, shall ensure that participants abide by the aforementioned. The Head Coach is the primary contact with TNSCTP and is responsible for ensuring all individuals associated with the team follow the rules and Code of Conduct.

TWF and TNSCTP reserves the right to approve the Head Coach for each team and will work with _____ (*Sponsoring Entity*) to find an approved coach.

TWF and TNSCTP will define the population area from which the team of _____ (*Sponsoring Entity*) may draw athletes. This area will be defined to provide fair competition amongst teams, prevent “cherry picking”, and accommodate as many athletes as possible.

_____ (*Sponsoring Entity*) agrees to support the team in recruiting athletes, promoting the team and TNSCTP, and promoting an outdoor lifestyle to the athletes it serves.

The parties hereby agree to submit any dispute to mediation within ninety (90) days of any disagreement between the parties. The only resolution available is mediation to all parties and the mediation shall be binding. Mediation is being used because it is faster and at the end of any mediation, the parties shall endeavor to maintain their relationship for the good of the youth of Tennessee.
